



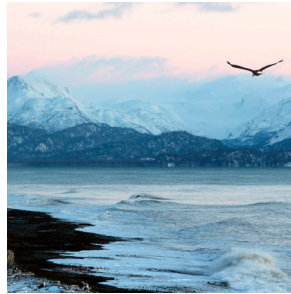

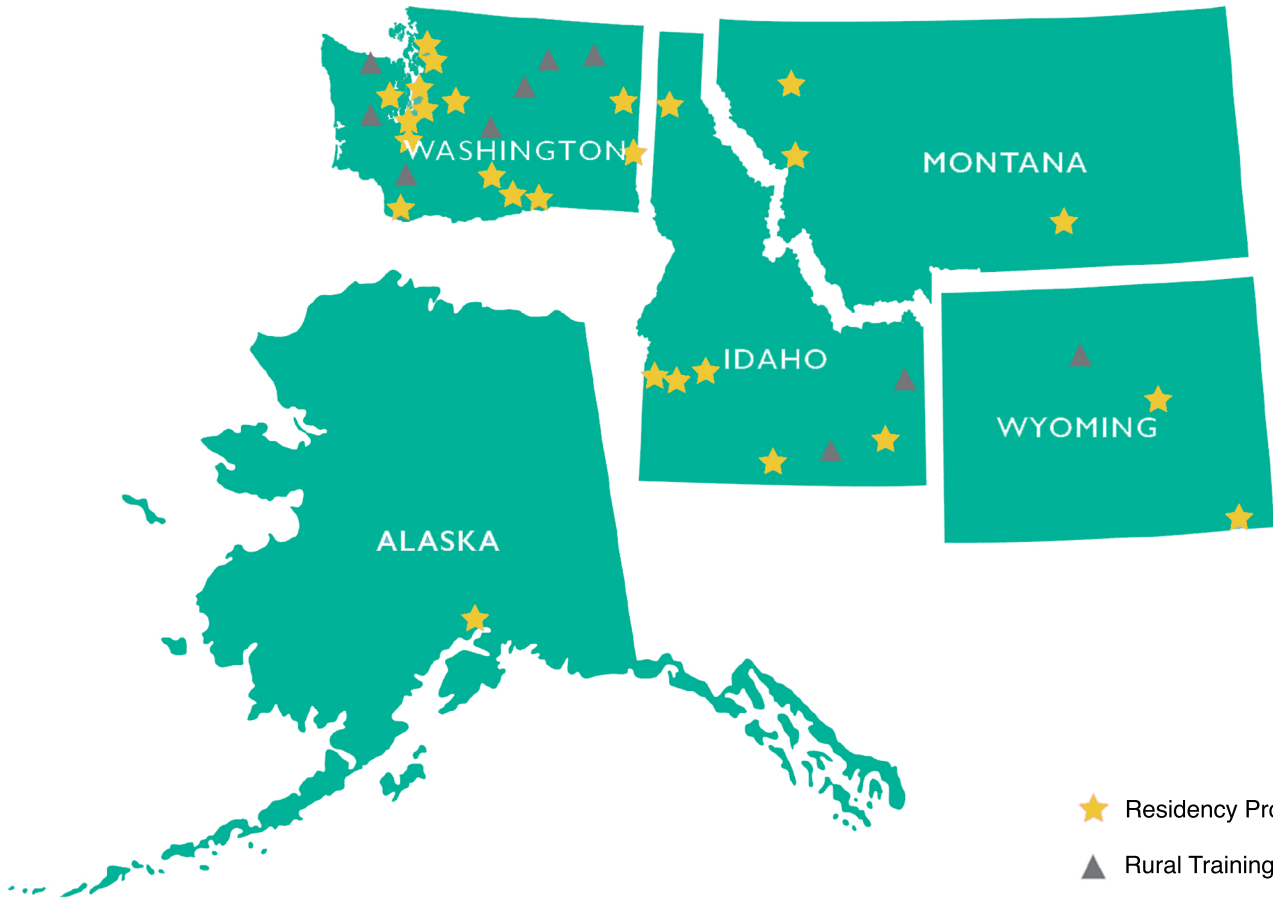

ABOUT OUR ORGANIZATION

The WWAMI Region Family Medicine Residency Network (WWAMI Network) is a group of family medicine residency programs related to each other by geography and university affiliation. The WWAMI Network is one of the largest residency networks in the United States, and now comprises 33 residency programs in Washington, Wyoming, Alaska, Montana and Idaho. In addition, there are a number of programs in development in the region.

OUR PURPOSE

The Network exists to promote excellence in family medicine residency education, to provide academic leadership, and to respond to societal needs for family physicians. The quality of the individual programs is high, reflected in the number and quality of applicants and residents, the excellence of the faculty, and the strong support of the sponsoring hospitals in providing up-to-date facilities and skilled staff.
