All licensed staff are considered mandated reporters and must report all suspected cases of abuse, neglect or exploitation. **Each licensed staff has a duty to report.** The person or people with first-hand knowledge of the suspected abuse/neglect/ exploitation are obligated to report. However, the individual suspecting abuse or neglect **will inform their chain of command** of their notification to community authorities/law enforcement.

Report within **48 hours** of suspicion of abuse/neglect.



If someone alleges any abuse/neglect/exploitation/abandonment **by staff**, report to your supervisor immediately.

Call Law Enforcement immediately when:

- 1. Requested by patient or his/her legal representative or family member;
- 2. The injury appears on the back, face, head, neck, chest, breasts, groin, inner thigh, buttock, genital, or anal area;
- 3. There is a fracture;
- 4. There is a pattern of physical assault between the same vulnerable adults or involving the same vulnerable adults;
- 5. There is an attempt to choke a vulnerable adult;
- 6. When there is reason to suspect that the death of a vulnerable adult was caused by abuse, neglect, or abandonment by another person;
- 7. When there is reason to suspect that sexual assault has occurred.
