<p>Candidates Who can receive prescriptions?</p>	<p>Adult and pediatric patients from any clinic who need a specialty medication may receive prescriptions from the specialty pharmacy.</p> <p>Most insurance plans are accepted. If the insurance company requires the fill take place at a non-MultiCare site, the specialty pharmacy team will ensure the prescription gets to the correct pharmacy.</p> <p>Call 253-403-8326 to determine if the medication can be dispensed through MultiCare's specialty pharmacy.</p>
<p>Prescribe How do I submit a prescription?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Epic users: Submit prescription to MULTICARE 002 TG MED CTR ED PHARMACY via Epic and pharmacy staff will access relevant information within the electronic health record. • For those without Epic: Send e-prescription to MULTICARE 002 TG MED CTR ED PHARMACY and fax chart notes, relevant labs and imaging, contraindications, and tried-and-failed treatments to 253-864-4086.
